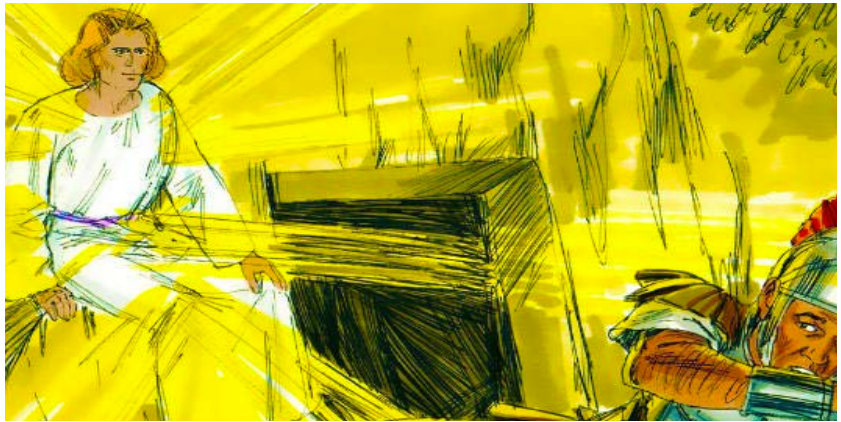
I am conscious that Fr Jim and Fr Liam, will want to wish you the joy of Easter also and I thank them for their support.
