[Ministry to the Sick - Arrangements for Visitation coming up to Christmas](#)

The sick and housebound who wish Fr Kieran to call to them before Christmas so that they can receive the Sacraments should contact the Parish Office. **A Visit can only take place when requested.** The sick and housebound should consult with family members or their GP to ensure it is safe to request visitation. Only one visit will be held per day between now and Christmas so do contact the Office early. Each requested visit will be carried out in compliance with Covid regulations.

Visitation to hospitals is not possible however families should be aware that there is always a chaplain available if needed. Families with loved ones in local nursing homes should discuss their pastoral needs with staff and contact the Parish Office if a visit is required.

Those with family members who are seriously ill should arrange a visit from the priest in good time. There is no need to leave it to the last minute as the priest may not be available. Families should never be concerned that the arrival of the priest will frighten the sick person. The pastoral visit is always about hope not fear. Those days are long gone and our understanding of the Sacraments has evolved greatly since Vatican II

Please note that in the event of a funeral in our parish church, the funeral Mass takes precedence over Month's Mind and Anniversary Masses that may have been booked. Where possible families will be contacted to inform them when this occurs. Arrangements can be made with the Parish Office to reschedule

Returning to Mass

Please consider the following ...

As you come to Mass or other Church Services please follow the guidance of our Ushers at all times and respect the fact that they are doing their best to keep you safe.

Know the risk

If you have any underlying medical condition please seek the advice from your medical practitioner who will advise if it is safe for you to return to Church.

Remember there is no obligation to return to Mass – you can watch Mass on the tv or webcams or listen on the radio. If you are a daily Mass goer you might consider staying at home at the weekends to make space for others.

Symptoms mean staying at Home

If you are feeling unwell or have any flu like symptoms please stay at home out of respect for others. It may be only a cold but do not risk the health of others. Please contact your G.P. if you are displaying symptoms such as cough, difficulty breathing, sneezing etc. If you display any symptoms of illness at Mass you may be invited to go to the designated area for your own safety and that of others.

Church Capacity

Church capacity is 50 people. Please understand when the church has reached capacity no further persons will be admitted.

Face Masks

The wearing of the face masks is now compulsory in Church. Face shields are now deemed not to be sufficient by health authorities.

Sanitise

When you arrive at Church please sanitise your hands before being seated and again on leaving the Church.

Seating

Please co-operate with the Ushers when it comes to finding a seat in the Church. There are no reserved seats

Social Distancing

Always respect social distancing guidelines and follow directions for Communion and leaving the Church. Do not gather in groups inside the Church but proceed outside immediately after Mass.

Secure Boxes will be available in our Churches for you to make a contribution. Donations can also be made online.

Baptisms, Weddings & Funerals

Please remember that Baptisms, Weddings & funerals can be celebrated in compliance with public health guidelines.

Baptisms are restricted to five people per family.

All Baptisms including those celebrated by a visiting priest are to be booked through the Parish Office and registered in the Parish of Baptism. Baptisms & other Sacraments celebrated by visiting priests are subject to parish guidelines and Covid guidelines. Dates & Times of Baptisms are available from the Parish Office.
