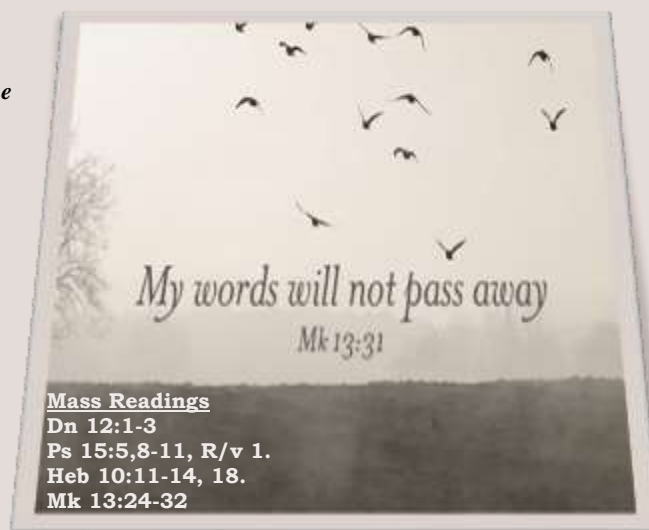

Pastoral Area Meeting: Walking and Working together



Next Wednesday evening 17th November a meeting of all Pastoral Council members of the four parishes of our Pastoral Area (Ferrybank, Glenmore, Rosbercon, Slieverue) will be held in St Mary's parish Centre, Slieverue at 7.30 pm

The purpose of this meeting is to begin reflect on the synodal process launched by Pope Francis recently and to identify concrete ways in which we as parishes can work together.

In case you are not familiar with the concept of 'synodality' it is simply how Pope Francis wants the Church to be a Church that listens and a Church that walks together on the pilgrim journey of life always aware that Jesus Christ is walking the road with us.

The new Greenway will be a great feature of life in our four parishes in the future for people to walk and enjoy the beautiful countryside around us. When we walk together as Church then we are walking the Gospel Greenway and better positioned to listen to the needs of all humanity and to walk with every person. Our meeting on Wednesday evening will explore ways of being a synodal locally. In 2023 a synod will be held in Rome to gather together all the reflections and the results of the listening process from around the world. Let us pray that what will emerge is Church that more than ever before listens to the voice of the Holy Spirit heard in the Word of God and through the people of God.

World day of the Poor

This Sunday we celebrate World Day of the Poor & also Safeguarding Sunday. World day of the Poor inaugurated by Pope Francis invites us to reflect on the plight of so many sisters and brothers who do not reach their full potential in life because of extreme poverty caused by natural disasters, wars and terrorism, economic injustice. World day of the poor invites us to cherish dignity of every human being.

Safeguarding Sunday

Safeguarding Sunday is an occasion to recommit ourselves to the safety of children, young adults and vulnerable persons in the Church Community. The horrible events of the past remind us to ever ask for forgiveness but also to ensure that all policies and procedures are in place to ensure the safety of all. A recent audit was conducted by diocesan personnel on our Safeguarding procedures and the results were very positive and complimentary. This was a very good way to prepare for a national audit of safeguarding practices which will be coming up in the new year and we will continue to monitor our practices, inviting more people to become involved in the area of safeguarding in our parishes as is recommended now by safeguarding bodies diocesan and national. A big thank you to our Safeguarding reps in both parishes for your continued role in this important area of Church life.

Remembering the Faithful Departed - Our Lady's Shrine at Knock

On this Sunday, the Bishops of Ireland will undertake a pilgrimage to the International Eucharistic and Marian Shrine at Knock to pastorally support everyone who has suffered the pain of bereavement during the pandemic and to pray for all who have died. The Bishops will concelebrate Mass at 3pm. This Mass will be live-streamed on www.knockshrine.ie and broadcast on the RTÉ News Now digital television channel and online.
