Sincere thanks, also to those who contribute to the Parish Clergy Fund which pays the Priest's salary and the Parish Church Fund which is used for the upkeep of parish property, diocesan expenses, the insurance and energy costs, as well as the support of retired priests. These regular payments through the Monthly Envelope Collection and the Offertory Collection are used to fund the parish, as well as the six income collections for the priest. Recently a number of families and individuals made their annual contribution - these are most gratefully received.

Please remember if your combined contribution to the Church and the Priest amounts to a minimum of €250 in one year, it enables the parish to claim the tax paid at the rate of 31% for both Selfemplyed and PAYE Taxpayers.
