Pope John Paul II Award

The Diocese of Ossory is keen to develop its youth ministry and is reintroducing this Award over the coming months into the Autumn. This Award is a faith achievement one for young people between the age of 16 and 18. Its key goal is to encourage and help participants to take an active part in the life of the Church and the wider community. It seeks to do so in ways that are 'noncompetitive, inclusive, flexible and voluntary'. The Award involves candidates committing to one hour per week in their parishes and one hour per week in their communities over eight, fourteen to twenty weeks depending on which Award level they are undertaking. If you would like to enrol for the Award, you can register your application with your School TY Coordinator. Hopefully all who engage will have a positive and enriching experience and in turn encourage others in the future to participate.
