Trócaire Lenten Campaign

Support Trócaire this Lent by taking a Trócaire envelope from the back of the church, available from next weekend, inside of which you will find your Lenten Trócaire box and give what you can to help support some of the poorest communities on the planet. The theme of the 2026 Trócaire Lenten campaign centres on the story of a multi-generational, female-led household in rural Rwanda. At just 28 years old, Uwamahoro is carrying the weight of three generations on her shoulders. She supports her mother, Verediana, 68, who lives with a disability, her daughter Ineza, 7 and her niece Vanessa, 12. Earning just 60 cent per day working on the land, Uwamahoro is doing the best she can to feed her family and keep the children in school, but it's never enough. The next storm could destroy everything Uwamahoro has built. We are asking the people of Ireland to help Uwamahoro rebuild her family's lives and restore their hopes for the future. 
