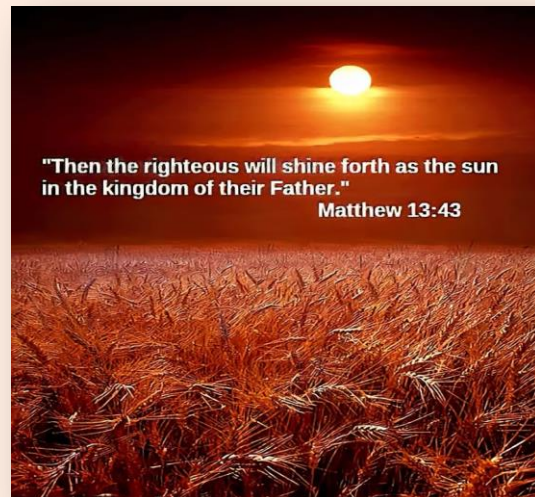

Croagh Patrick

The 2026 Reek Sunday falls on 26th July, and thousands of pilgrims of all ages – from across the island and from abroad – are expected to climb Croagh Patrick, Ireland's Holy Mountain, to pray and participate on the summit in the Sacraments of Reconciliation (Confession), and of the Eucharist. This year, we offer special prayer intention for Road Safety. Father John Kenny, the Administrator of Westport Parish, which includes Croagh Patrick, encouraged in a special way pilgrims travelling by road to participate in the climb, to do so safely.
